

#### BY 3 DAYS OF AGE:

SUPPLEMENTATION with IRON:

Ferroforte (comes in 100mL bottle) – 1mL DOSE

• Piglets:

ALL piglets to get one dose no later than 3 days of age

#### AT WEANING:

VACCINATION against WASTING DISEASES:

Circo Virus

Circoflex (comes in 50 dose bottles) - 1mL DOSE

## 21 day withdrawal

- Piglets:
  - One dose ONCE at 3 weeks of age

## AT WEANING AND 3-4 WEEKS LATER:

VACCINATION against SOIL-BORNE disease: *Erysipelas* 

ER Bac Plus (comes in 50 dose bottles) – 2mL DOSE

# 21 day withdrawal

- Piglets:
  - 2ml dose at >4 weeks of age
  - Booster 2ml dose 3-4 weeks after first dose

VACCINATION against SOIL-BORNE disease: *Clostridial Disease*  **Ultrachoice 8** (comes in 50 dose bottles) – **2mL DOSE 21 day withdrawal** 

- Piglets:
  - 2ml dose at weaning
  - Booster 2ml dose 3-4 weeks after first dose

#### AROUND 6-10 WEEKS OF AGE AND 4-5 WEEKS BEFORE SLAUGHTER:

DEWORMING:

Safeguard (does not treat mites or threadworms)

0 day withdrawal

OR

Ivomec (does not treat trichuris suis, but does treat mange/mites)

28 day withdrawal (injectable) 14 day withdrawal (top dress)

- Finishing Pigs:
  - Treat between 6 and 10 weeks old
  - Treat 4-5 weeks prior to slaughter (about 21 to 25 weeks)

# If you find milk spot livers after one turn of this deworming protocol, add in a 3<sup>rd</sup> deworming dose in the finisher pigs (about week 15/16)!!!



\*\*\*Note: you can rotate dewormers\*\*\*
